Wound/Venous Stasis Ulcer

Wounds are classified with increased specificity according to three criteria: [a] location on limb, [b] side (right/left) and [c] severity. L97 means the wound is a non-pressure chronic ulcer. The digits after the decimal specify location, side, and severity, as follows: L97.[a][b][c]

1 = thigh 1 = right 1 = limited breakdown of skin

2 = calf 2 = left 2 = fat layer exposed

3 = ankle 3 = unspecified 3 = necrosis of muscle

8 = other part of lower leg

9 = unspecified part of lower leg

Example: Right ankle wound with unspecified severity = L97.319.
